

Summer Day Camp

A few notes regarding camps.....

- NSRS' core day camps- Discover, Explore & Adventure are six weeks in length and are scheduled Monday - Thursday. These camps will maintain a constant location, schedule, and staff.
- Field Trip Fridays, which is a separate sign up, will occur each week, except on July 2, 2021.
- NSRS reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of participants in all camps.
- Please send your camper with a lunch, water bottle, swimsuit, towel and sunscreen every day.
- All PM campers must arrive by 12:30pm.
- All camps will function at a 1:4 staff to camper ratio. Campers must be independent in eating, dressing, toileting, personal hygiene, following instructions and safety protocols. This includes wearing a mask properly, over nose and mouth, social distancing, and using hand sanitizer. We cannot accept any campers who wear diapers/pull ups, all campers must be independent while using the toilet.
- Due to mitigations and Covid-19 protocols, we will enforce a hard capacity on registration numbers.
- Parents must be able to answer Covid-19 questions each day prior to a staff accepting your child into camp.

Deposit & Payment

A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration. This deposit will be subtracted from the amount owed for summer camp. NSRS is offering a monthly payment plan, starting in May and making your last payment July 19, 2021.

All camp fees must be paid in full by Monday, July 19, 2021

Parent Packet

Once you are registered for summer camp, NSRS will need additional information about each camper. A Parent Packet will include a Parent Camper Guide, Directions & Maps, Authorization for Pick-Up Form, Medication Dispensing and Waiver, Parent Questionnaire and Annual Information Form. Please include a copy of the most recent I.E.P. **All paperwork is due by June 7, 2021 to begin camp on Monday, June 14, 2021.** Additional paperwork may be required.

The Parent Packet will be available on the NSRS website and for pick up at the NSRS Office starting May 17, 2021.

CAMP REGISTRATION DEADLINE

A completed Registration Form and Parent Packet must be turned in by Monday, June 7, 2021 for your camper to begin on June 14, 2021.

Paperwork turned in after June 7, camper will begin camp once paperwork had been processed. Paperwork turned in after camp has started, camper will start a minimum of **48 hours** after completed paperwork has been processed.

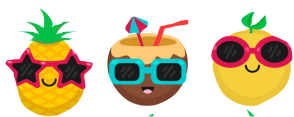
